Goal: Increase parental input into school decision making

Relates to Board Priority: Encourage active involvement of First Nation parents

Rationale: Survey results indicate inconsistent results in the area of satisfaction with parent feedback. Surveys are also completed by a low number of respondents. In joining a new school, administration finds value in hearing parent opinions and input and believes this is imperative in building school relationships.

## Strategy

 Through parent meetings, paper and electronic surveys, and invitations for input, opportunity for parent feedback will be facilitated

## **Practices**

- Increase Accountability
   Pillar survey responses by providing mail drop-off opportunity at school, messaging its importance through parent letter and newsletter
- Survey all parents on key Accountability Pillar questions
- Hold community input meeting and survey regarding desired school messaging, and other school decisions
- Provide invitation to contact the school through Facebook, website, and newsletter

## Measurement

- Evidence Jan/Feb parent meeting and survey regarding school messaging, survey station at March Parent Teacher Interviews, monthly newsletter and online invitations and questions
- Results 60% parent response rate on Accountability Pillar questions; 80% parent satisfaction rate on parental involvement in school decisions
